

Merrimac Scarecrows 2020

1. DIRECTIONS FOR STUFFING: Do not fill your scarecrow with anything that will mold such as hay. We suggest that you fill plastic shopping bags with crumpled up newspaper. Tie, staple or tape onto stick or use to stuff arms, legs, and head this way. Work gloves or plastic gloves work well for hands. It is not necessary to change your scarecrow every year and it is yours to put out every year without further payment.
2. Tip: You can use a drill or a crowbar to start hole prior to driving the stake in the ground. DO NOT PUSH ON THE SHOULDERS.
3. In October place the scarecrow in a location that can be seen from the road. Please place it away from the edge of the road to avoid distracting drivers. A picture of the scarecrow would be greatly appreciated posted on the Facebook Page Merrimac Old Home Days.
4. We suggest that you bring the scarecrow in on October 30th so that nothing happens when the ghouls are out. Kept dry in the off season the scarecrow should be usable for years.
